In my capacity as an Aviation Project Manager for the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Aviation Division, we have specified and utilized sealer/rejuvenators on many airport projects. Those airports which have been directly under my supervision include: Sweetwater Municipal Airport, Sweetwater, Texas, La Porte Municipal Airport, La Porte, Texas, Hereford Municipal Airport, Hereford, Texas, Scurry County Airport, Scurry County, Texas.

The contractor for these projects, BCL Pavement Services, has utilized a sealer/rejuvenator which has been certified by the manufacturer to meet the FAA Engineering Brief 44. On the projects identified above, we have observed no problems with the products intended performance. After application of RejuvaSeal, the asphalt surface has a very black appearance with exceptional contrast to the new or existing airport paint markings. RejuvaSeal has assisted in stopping oxidation and the loss of fines that some older asphalt surfaces experience.
